# 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Student Statement of Cooperation

It is the philosophy of Northeast Baptist School that students in the upper grade levels are to be an example to the younger students. In order to help all of our students develop strong character, a certain amount of discipline must be maintained. A person's character and relationship with Christ are reflected in all aspects of his or her life. It is not only what you say but what you do that determines how a person is perceived.

Therefore the following Statement of Cooperation shall serve as a guide for all 7th – 12th grade NBS students.

- 1. <u>God created us and redeemed us so that we may bring glory to God in all we do</u>.

  I Corinthians 10:31 "So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God."
- 2. Responsibility to Others "Honor all men." 1 Peter 2:17

  Students are expected to conduct themselves in a responsible manner at all times, always giving consideration to others first. Students are to maintain the highest standard of respect for teachers, staff, parents, other adults and fellow students.
- 3. Responsibility for Property "Do not steal, deal falsely, or lie to one another" Lev. 19:11

  Students are expected to act responsibly regarding property, whether it is the property of the school, others, or their own. Any behavior which may damage or deface property is forbidden and will be dealt with accordingly. Students shall not lie, cheat, or steal, nor shall they tolerate such conduct in any other student.
- 4. Profanity, Obscenity, and Vulgar Language or Conduct.

"Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths." Ephesians 4:29
Students must speak and act in keeping with Christian standards, and must not interfere with the educational process. Profane, obscene, and vulgar language, gestures, and conduct, and materials are prohibited.

#### 5. Student Attitudes

"Your attitude should be the same as that of Jesus Christ." Philippians 2:5

A student's attitude either strengthens or hinders the educational process. Students are expected to display an obedient, cooperative attitude that will create a stronger environment for learning and development.

### 6. Student Effort

"And whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, and not for men. Colossians 3:23

Students are expected to exert their best effort in all areas of activities.

#### 7. Dress Code

A major part of Christian Citizenship is teaching children to dress appropriately and to adhere to required standards of dress. In order to maintain a positive Christian and academic atmosphere at NBS, students are expected to be clean, neat, and appropriately dressed.
