

Supply List - 2017-2018 Northeast Baptist School Rev 1

K3 - K4 - K5 Please turn in no later than orientation.

Backpack – Regular sized (not mini) - large enough to hold speckled book, jackets, folders, and lunchbox. Preschool students cannot have rolling backpacks. Please put their name in an easily visible location.

EXTRA CHANGE of CLOTHES: Students need to have the following items in the classroom in a gallon zip lock bag with their name on it: one pair of shorts, one pair of long pants, one short sleeve shirt, one long sleeve shirt, two underpants, two pairs of socks, one pair of old shoes. These are not uniform clothes and will be returned at the end of the year if unused. Soiled clothes will be sent home immediately. The items used from their EXTRA CLOTHES bag must be replenished after they are sent home. When these extras are properly maintained, it allows us not to call you at work for accidents.

Class fees are used to pay for: A playground fee, snack, and teacher purchased Preschool (K3, K4, K5) supplies (each group varies)- crayons, glue stick, color and regular pencils, scissors, supply boxes, glue, folders, supplies, play-doh, grippers, and art/science supplies.

Algebra 1 and Advanced math only - Graphing Calculator- TI83 or later only

Geometry - A sturdy Protractor (not the \$1 ones)

Choose one: 1) Separate subjects - ½ inch binders with pockets - add wide-ruled loose leaf paper

2) One 1 ½ inch 3 ring binder with manila pocketed dividers - add wide-ruled loose leaf paper
